

Who runs the course?

Weather:

Terms and conditions:

Subject to the provisions below, all course fees are non-refundable & non-transferable.

We do not offer alternative dates if you need to cancel the dates that you have booked.

Payment of the full course fee is required to secure your booking.

Your course fee is only returnable in the event of you informing Go Wild Go West of a cancellation with more than 4 weeks' notice prior to your course commencing.

A full refund of your course fee will be available should Go Wild Go West have to cancel the event for any reason.

If you cancel your course space with less than 4 weeks' notice we will only reimburse you the fee if we are able to re-sell the course space on your behalf.

You should ensure you are fully insured for your course to cover all cancellation, equipment loss or theft.

COVID-19: In the event that any future COVID-19 lockdown measures imposed by the English or Welsh governments should make it impossible for us to run your course lawfully, we shall cancel the event and provide a full refund of your course fee. We will be unable however to provide refunds to any individuals unable to attend a course due to self-isolation and would strongly encourage anyone booking with us to consider obtaining travel insurance which covers such a scenario.
